

Appointment Guidelines

It is our goal to make dental care a pleasant and rewarding experience for you and your child(ren).

1. Please keep your regularly scheduled appointments.
To maximize treatment success, keeping appointments is important.
2. If you are more than 10 minutes late for your appointment, we may need to reschedule.
We want to be on time for you. Arriving late for your appointment can make it impossible for us to complete the procedures that have been scheduled.
3. Appointments Requiring Special Scheduling
Certain procedures may call for particular circumstances. If we feel your child's treatment requires more uninterrupted attention and less distraction, we may ask you to schedule the appointment during a specific time of day.
4. Whenever it is not possible to keep an appointment, please call our office 48 hours in advance.
This will avoid a missed-appointment charge and allow us to offer your appointment time to another patient waiting for treatment.
5. Emergencies
We always try our best to be on time. Occasionally, however, a patient may need unexpected care. We appreciate your patience under these circumstances.
